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HOMOEOPATHIC APPROACH FOR ALLERGY

ABSTRACT- Allergic diseases are a common and increasing cause of illness, they comprise a range of disorders from mild to life threatening, and affect many organs. Homoeopathy plays an important role in the treatment and prevention of allergy, whereas the other mode of

treatment are unable to give permanent cure of allergic patient. Our homoeopathy not only cure, but prevent as well as minimizing the recurrence of allergy. Whereas the other pathy fails to do this, they only gives temporary relief of the disease. These diseases are usually psoric origin and they are dynamic diseases, and our homoeopathic medicine are dynamic in nature. Dynamic homoeopathic remedy acts immune system to regulised its response.

INTRODUCTION- To define "Allergy", or even to understand the word meaning is not so easy since the involvement of the spear is much wider even to explain or

to understand. It may differ person to person in its action.

Allergy is a state of hypersensitiveness to one or more allergens. A damaging immune response by the body to substance, especially a particular food, pollen, fur, or dust to which it has become hypersensitive.

LITERATURE STUDY-

Immunity- immunity play an important role in case of hypersensitivity and allergy. the word immunity is synonymous with resistance meaning protection from particular disease or injuries, whereas the term hypersensitivity is interchangeable with allergy meaning a state of exaggerated or altered immune response to a given agent. The disease of the immune system are broadly classified into the following four groups-

1) Immunodeficiency disorders- characterised by deficient cellular and/or humoral immune function. This group is comprised by a list of primary and secondary immunodeficiency diseases including the dreaded acquired immunodeficiency syndrome(AIDS).

2) Hypersensitivity reactions- characterised by hyperfunction of the immune system and cover the various mechanism of immunologic tissue injury.

3) Autoimmune disease- occur when the immune system fails to recognize "self" from "non- self". A growing number of autoimmune and collagen diseases are included in this group.

4) Possible immune disorders- immunologic mechanisms are suspected in their etiopathogenesis.

The basic reasons of allergy are still an unknown factor and we may recognize the allergy only by symptoms, food, allergy, suppressed due to medical reaction, skin allergy. allergy due to climatic change are the some recognized categories.

SITES OF AFFECTION- The allergy may take place to affect any part of the body like brain, nervous system, nose, eye, ear, chest and stomach/abdomen, skin.

"However to understand the term allergy in the medical science is different. Any substance which may disagree to the body if applied and leads to underivable harmless reaction to the person may be termed as allergy". The cause of reaction may differ from person to person.

PATOLOGY OF ALLERGY- The tendency to produce an exaggerated IgE immune response to otherwise harmless environmental substances, while an allergic diseases can be defined as the clinical manifestation of this inappropriate IgE immune response.

The immune system does not make detectable response to the many environmental substances to which it is exposed daily. In an allergic reaction, initial exposure to an otherwise harmless exogenous substance (known as allergen) triggers the production of specific IgE antibodies by activated B cell.

These IgE antibodies bend to the surface to mast cell via high-affinity IgE receptors, a step that is not itself associated with clinical sequels, upon re-exposure, the allergen binds to membrane-bound IgE which activates the mast cell, releasing a variety of mediators. This type I hypersensitivity reaction is the basis of the symptoms of allergic reactions, which range from sneezing and rhinorrhoea to anaphylaxis.

SUSCEPTIBILITY TO ALLERGIC DISEASES- A number of factors predispose to allergic diseases, the strongest of which is a family history. A wide array of genetic determinates of disease susceptibility have been identified, including genes controlling innate immune responses, cytokine production, IgE levels and the ability to the epithelial barrier to protect against environmental agents. Contributory environmental factors include bacterial and viral infection, pollutants and cigarette smoke.

ROLE OF MIASM- Allergic diseases are considered as chronic diseases. The causes of all chronic diseases are miasms. The psora is the root cause or primary cause of all disease conditions.

MANAGEMENT- The primary objective of homoeopathic treatment is to consider the primary symptoms of patient which is a morbid process expressing in the form of general symptoms. Homoeopathy considered patient with his mental and physical aspect which gets affected primarily as morbid vital process. Homoeopathy is a science of vital dynamics.

The morbid vital process ultimates in the pathology the primary symptoms which represent the individual in the form of mental symptoms and physical general symptoms form the basis of prescription.

SELECTION OF MEDICINE- When the patient is hypersensitive and allergic, we must avoid or use of the C.M. and other high potencies, which will make our patient sick and may causes unwanted aggravation, instead of very high use Hahnemann dilution method in decimal or 50 millesimal.

POTENCY- medium potency (to avoid sever form of aggravation).

HOMOEOPATHIC REMEDIES FOR ALLERGY-

1) ALLIUM CEPA, EUPHRASIA, SABADILLA- Hay fever, running nose.

2) ARSENIC ALB & ARSENIC IOD, ANTIMONIUM TART- Bronchitis/Asthma.

3) SABADILLA, EUPHRASIA- Watering of eyes, Burning and itching of eyes and sneezing.

4) RHUS TOX, ANTIMONIUM CRUDE, ANTIMONIUM TART, GRAPHITES, PETROLEUM- For skin disease such as nettle- rash, eczema measles, cracks on the palms, sole, etc.

CHRONIC DISEASE- Treatment chronic disease condition caused by chronic miasm so the treatment antimiasmatic or constitutional medicine.

CONCLUSION- Thus the scope of homoeopathy stands very high in the treatment of allergy and far superior than treatment with Modern medicine, it cures the patient.

ABDOMINAL BLOATING AND HOMOEOPATHY

Introduction:

Heatstroke is a life threatening condition where your body overheats. Its more common in hot, humid weather. It occurs when the body can no longer control its temperature. The body temperature rises rapidly, the sweating mechanism fails, and the body is unable to cool down.

A core temperature is less than 40°C accompanied by CNS dysfunction in patients with environmental heat exposure. This condition represents a failure of the body's ability to maintain thermoregulatory homeostasis.

Cause

Heat stroke can occur if body temperature rises to 104°F (40°C) or higher.

Classification

1. Classic heat stroke: More common in younger children who are unable to escape from hot environment and those with underlying chronic medical condition that impair thermoregulation.
2. Exertional heat stroke: generally occurs in healthy individuals who engage in heavy exercise during periods of high temperature and humidity. Typical patients are athletes and military recruits in basic training.

Risk-

- Elderly
- Children
- Military
- outdoor workers (construction, roofers, migrant work)

Clinical features:-

First stage - Heat cramps are the initial sign of heat illness. Cramps and spasms will occur due to dehydration or an electrolyte imbalance.

HEAT STROKE

Investigation-

- Rapid blood glucose to identify hypoglycemia.
- CBC, PT/PTT, INR and serum electrolytes.
- Urea and creatinine to identify prerenal azotemia or renal failure resulting from myoglobinuria.
- Serum (Ca²⁺), ionized or total calcium, and phosphate to detect rhabdomyolysis, hypocalcemia, and hyperphosphatemia.
- Toxicologic screening for drugs of abuse or prescribed medication.
- Chest radiography: identify pulmonary edema.
- Computed tomography: identify the pressure in brain.

Prehospital care or treatment -

1. Cooling might have occurred prior to the arrival of the hospital.
2. Removal from the source of heat stress and rapid initiation of cooling as the risk of morbidity and mortality for patients with heat-related illness is associated with the duration of hyperthermia.
3. Patients with heat stroke should be treated with either ice water immersion or evaporative external cooling in the field.
4. Pre-hospital cooling measure should be initiated prior to or simultaneously with activation of emergency medical services.

Treatment

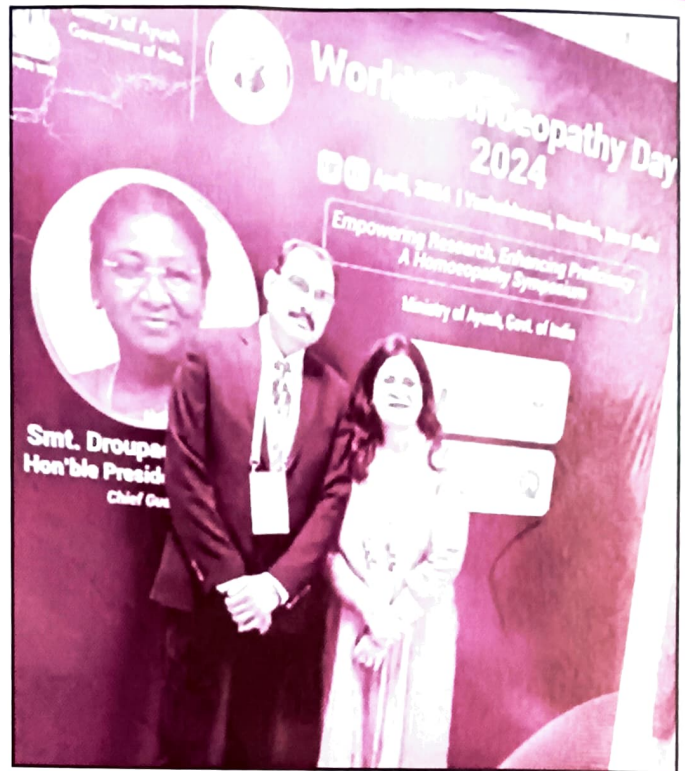
1. Glonoin - heat stroke
 - It exposes to sun it causes headache.
 - Sensation is throbbing, pulsating type of headache.
 - Aggravation - sun heat of fire.
2. Gelsemium sempervirens-
 - It exposes to sun it causes headache and remittent fever.
 - It causes DULNESS, DIZZINESS and DROWSINESS and muscular weakness, desire for absolute rest. Thirstlessness is well marked.
 - Aggravation - sun, heat stroke.
 - Amelioration - profuse urination.
3. Natrum muriaticum -
 - It exposes to sun it causes mainly symptoms: headache, skin disease, fever, urinary symptoms.
 - Sensation - as if a thousand little hammers are knocking on the brain.
 - Aggravation - sunrise especially 10 to 11 am.
 - Amelioration - open air, cold bathing.
4. Syphilinum -
